2 finally adopted, is available for sale at the office of the city clerk at a price reflecting cost
3 to the City as established by the City Manager, pursuant to this municipal code. The City
4 shall keep a copy of the adopted code in the office of the chief enforcement officer for
5 public inspection.

6 16.08.030 Article 80.2 amended - Definitions

7 Article 80.2 of the National Electrical Code is amended by deletion of the
8 definition for Electrical Inspector.

9 16.08.040 Article 80.13(2) amended – Authority.

10 Article 80.13 of the National Electrical Code is amended by modification of the
11 first sentence of item (2) as follows:

12 (2) When the use of any electrical equipment or its installations is found to be dangerous
13 to human life or property, the authority having jurisdiction shall be empowered to have
14 the premises disconnected from its source of electric supply.

15 16.08.050 Article 80.13(13) amended – Authority.

16 Article 80.13 of the national Electrical Code is amended by modification of the
17 second sentence of item (13) as follows:

18 The authority having jurisdiction shall be notified when the installation is ready for
19 inspection.

20 16.08.060 Article 80.15 replaced – Electrical Board.

21 Article 80.15 of the National Electrical Code is replaced with the following:

22 80.15 Appeals. For provisions relating to the board of appeals, see Chapter 16.30,
23 Longmont Municipal Code.

1 16.08.070 Article 80.23(B) replaced- Penalties.

2 Article 80.23(B) of the National Electrical Code is replaced with the following:

3 (B) Penalties

4 (1) Unlawful acts. It is unlawful for any person to erect, install, alter, repair,
5 relocate, add to, replace, demolish, use, occupy or maintain any building or
6 structure, or cause or permit the same to be done, in violation of this code.

7 (2) Violation. Any person committing or permitting a violation of this code
8 commits a separate offense for each day or part of a day during which the
9 violation exists. Offenses are punishable according to Chapter 1.12. of the
10 Longmont Municipal Code.

11 (3) Violation penalties. Imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not
12 excuse the violation nor permit it to continue, and all such persons shall
13 correct or remedy such violations or defect within a reasonable time.

14 (4) Prosecution of violation. In addition to any other penalties, any violation of
15 this code is a public nuisance and shall be enjoined by a court of competent
16 jurisdiction. Nothing in this code shall prevent the city attorney from seeking
17 appropriate legal or equitable relief from any court of competent jurisdiction

18 16.08.080 Article 80.25 deleted – Connection to Electricity Supply

19 Article 80.25 of the National Electrical Code is deleted in its entirety.

20 16.08.090 Article 80.27 deleted – Inspector’s Qualifications.

21 Article 80.27 of the National Electrical Code is deleted in its entirety.

22 16.08.100 Article 80.29 amended –Liability for Damages.

23 Article 80.29 of the National Electrical Code is amended by insertion of *City of*

1 *Longmont* in the blank space.

2 16.08.110 Article 80.35 deleted – Effective Date.

3 Article 80.35 of the National Electrical Code is deleted.

4 16.08.140 Article 210.11(C) amended – Dwelling Units.

5 Article 210.11(C) of the National Electrical Code is amended by the addition of a
6 new sub-section (4) as follows:

7 (4) Basement Circuits In addition to the number of branch circuits required by other parts
8 of this section, at least one 15 ampere, and one 20ampere circuit shall be installed in a
9 junction box located in the basement for future use.

10 16.08.180 Article 394.10 deleted – Uses Permitted.

11 Article 394.10 of the National Electrical Code is deleted in its entirety.

12 **Section 2 Validity.**

13 To the extent only that they conflict with this ordinance, the council repeals any
14 conflicting ordinances or parts of ordinances. The provisions of this ordinance are
15 severable, and invalidity of any part shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
16 rest of this ordinance. Neither the adoption of this ordinance nor its action repealing or
17 amending any other ordinance of the City Of Longmont shall, in any manner affect
18 prosecution for violations of ordinances committed before the effective date of this
19 ordinance. This ordinance shall not waive any license, fee or penalty due and unpaid
20 under pre-existing ordinances on its effective date. This ordinance shall not affect any
21 pre-existing ordinances on the collection of any license, fee or penalty, or the penal
22 provisions applicable to any violation thereof. This ordinance shall not affect the validity

1 of any bond or cash deposit required under any ordinance. All rights and obligations
2 under such security shall continue in full force and effect.

3 **Section 3 Effective date.**

4 This ordinance shall become effective on March 15, 2006 or ten days after final
5 publication, whichever comes later.
