

1 ORDINANCE-O-2007-19

2 A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.22 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
3 FOR THE CITY OF LONGMONT, COLORADO, TO ADOPT, BY REFERENCE, THE 2006  
4 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE

6 WHEREAS according to Part 2 of Article 16 of Title 31, CRS, as amended, and Article  
7 IV, Municipal Charter of the City of Longmont, Colorado, the Longmont City Council has  
8 previously adopted, by reference, the International Energy Conservation Code, 2003 Edition; and

9 WHEREAS the agency or organization by whom it was promulgated has revised or  
10 amended such code or statute, after its previous adoption by reference; and

11 WHEREAS the Longmont City Council has determined, pursuant to Section 4.10 of the  
12 Municipal Charter for the City of Longmont, to adopt that revised or amended version;

13 NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGMONT, COLORADO,  
14 ORDAINS:

15 Section 1 International Energy Conservation Code Adopted.

16 Chapter 16.22 of the Longmont Municipal Code is hereby repealed and reenacted to read  
17 as follows:

18 16.22.010 International Energy Conservation Code adopted.

19 Pursuant to Part 2 of Article 16 of Title 31, CRS, as amended, and Article  
20 IV, Municipal Charter of the City of Longmont, Colorado, there is adopted as the  
21 energy code of the City, by reference thereto, the International Energy  
22 Conservation Code, 2006 Edition, published by the International Code Council,  
23 Inc., 5203 Leesburg Pike, Suite 600, Falls Church, Virginia 22041, that code to  
24 have the same force and effect as if set forth in this chapter in every particular,  
25 save and except such portions as are added, amended, deleted, or replaced in this  
26 chapter. All references in this code to the International Energy Conservation  
27 Code are to the edition referenced above.

28 16.22.020 Copies--Filing for public inspection. Sale.

29 At the time of adoption, one certified true copy of the International Energy  
30 Conservation Code, published by the International Code Council is on file in the

1 office of the city clerk and may be inspected by any interested person between the  
2 hours of eight a.m. and five p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excepted.  
3 The city shall keep a copy of the adopted code in the office of the chief  
4 enforcement officer for public inspection. The building code, as finally adopted, is  
5 available for sale at the office of the city clerk, at a price reflecting cost to the city  
6 as established by the city manager, pursuant to this municipal code.

7 16.22.030 Section 101.1 amended—Title.

8 International Energy Conservation Code is amended by insertion of “the  
9 City of Longmont” in the brackets.

10 16.22.040 Section 101.2 amended Scope

11 Section 101.2 of the International Energy Conservation Code is amended  
12 by substituting “adopted Electrical Code” for “ICC Electrical Code” in all  
13 sections throughout this code.

14 16.22.050 Section 401.3 Certificate

15 Section 401.3 of the International Energy Conservation Code is amended  
16 by the revision of the first sentence as follows “A permanent certificate shall be  
17 posted in a conspicuous location on the job site.”

18 16.22.060 Scope.

19 Section 404.1 of the International Energy Conservation Code is amended  
20 by the addition of Section 404.1.1 Service water heating.

21 The minimum Energy Factor for residential water heaters shall be .60 for  
22 fuel fired and .92 for electric water heaters.
