



1           At the time of adoption, one copy of the International Plumbing Code,  
2 published by the International Code Council Inc., certified to be a true copy is on  
3 file in the office of the city clerk and may be inspected by any interested person  
4 between the hours of eight a.m. and five p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays  
5 excepted. The city shall keep a copy of the adopted code in the office of the chief  
6 enforcement officer for public inspection. The building code, as finally adopted, is  
7 available for sale at the office of the city clerk, at a price reflecting cost to the city  
8 as established by the city manager, pursuant to this municipal code.

9           16.16.030 Section 101.1 amended--Title.

10           Section 101.1 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by insertion  
11 of “the City of Longmont” within the brackets.

12           16.16.040 Section 101.2 amended Scope

13           Section 101.2 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by  
14 substituting “adopted Electrical Code” for “ICC Electrical Code” in all sections  
15 throughout this code.

16           16.16.060 Section 105.4 deleted--Alternative engineered design.

17           Sections 105.4 through 105.4.6 of the International Plumbing Code are  
18 deleted in their entirety.

19           16.16.070 Section 106.6.2 replaced--Fee schedule.

20           Section 106.6.2 of the International Plumbing Code is deleted in its  
21 entirety and replaced with the following:

22           The fee for any permit required by this code shall be established from time  
23 to time by resolution of the city council.

24           16.16.080 Section 106.6.3 amended--Fee refunds.

25           Section 106.6.3 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by  
26 inserting “eighty percent” into the brackets of paragraphs numbered 2 and 3.

27           16.16.090 Section 107.2 deleted--Special inspections.

28           Sections 107.2 through 107.2.2 of the International Plumbing Code are  
29 deleted in their entirety.

30           16.16.100 Section 108 replaced--Violations.

1           Section 108 International Plumbing Code is deleted in its entirety, and  
2 replaced with the following:

3           108.1 Unlawful acts. It is unlawful for any person to erect, install, alter,  
4 repair, relocate, add to, replace, demolish, use, occupy or maintain any building or  
5 structure, or cause or permit the same to be done, in violation of this code.

6           108.2 Violation. Any person committing or permitting a violation of this  
7 code commits a separate offense for each day or part of a day during which the  
8 violation exists. Offenses are punishable according to Chapter 1.12 of the  
9 Longmont Municipal Code.

10          108.3 Violation penalties. Imposition of one penalty for any violation  
11 shall not excuse the violation nor permit it to continue, and all such persons shall  
12 correct or remedy such violations or defect within a reasonable time.

13          108.4 Prosecution of violation. In addition to any other penalties, any  
14 violation of this code is a public nuisance and shall be enjoined by a court of  
15 competent jurisdiction. Nothing in this code shall prevent the city attorney from  
16 seeking appropriate legal or equitable relief from any court of competent  
17 jurisdiction.

18 16.16.110 Section 109 replaced--Means of appeal.

19          Section 109 of the International Plumbing Code is deleted in its entirety,  
20 and replaced with the following:

21          109.1 General. For provisions relating to the Board of Appeals, see  
22 section 16.30 of the Longmont Municipal Code.

23 16.16.120 Section 312.4 deleted--Drainage and vent final test.

24          Section 312.4 of the International Plumbing Code is deleted in its entirety.

25 16.16.130 Section 312.9 deleted--Inspection and testing of backflow prevention  
26 assemblies.

27          Section 312.9 of the International Plumbing Code is deleted in its entirety.

28 16.16.140 Section 501.1 amended Scope

29          Section 501.1 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by the  
30 addition of the following

1 The minimum energy factor for residential electric water heaters shall be .92 and  
2 .60 for fuel-fired types.

3 16.16.150 Section 607 Hot water supply system

4 Section 607.1 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by the  
5 deletion of sentence four.

6 16.16.180 Section 712.3.1 amended--Sump pump.

7 Section 712.3.1 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by the  
8 addition of the following:

9 In public use occupancies, dual pumps shall be required and shall be  
10 arranged to function independently.

11 16.16.210 Section 901.6 deleted--Engineered systems.

12 Section 901.6 of the International Plumbing Code is deleted in its entirety.

13 16.16.220 Section 904.1 amended--Roof extension.

14 Section 904.1 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by inserting  
15 the number “6” in the brackets.

16 16.16.250 Section 908.2 amended--Connection at the same level.

17 Section 908.2 of the International Plumbing Code is amended by deleting  
18 the last five words of the section.

19 16.16.260 Section 910 deleted--Waste stack vent.

20 Section 910 and Table 910.4 of the International Plumbing Code are  
21 deleted in their entirety.

22 16.16.290 Section 918 deleted--Engineered vent systems.

23 Section 918 and Table 918.2 of the International Plumbing Code are  
24 deleted in their entirety.
