



CODE ENFORCEMENT MONTHLY REPORT

FEBRUARY 2009

- 2 full time Code Enforcement Inspectors and the Code Enforcement Supervisor responded to 115 complaints from citizens on code violations. 26 additional code violations were pro-actively identified.
- 2 full time Code Enforcement Inspectors and the Code Enforcement Supervisor initiated 171 new cases in February in addition to the associated workload and re-inspections on existing cases.
- The top code activity in February was graffiti, with 46 cases.
- 3 parking tickets were issued for a parking violations related to junked vehicles on public streets.
- Code Enforcement Inspectors performed a total of 512 inspections related to code and housing violations.
