



CODE ENFORCEMENT MONTHLY REPORT

MARCH 2009

- 2 full time Code Enforcement Inspectors and the Code Enforcement Supervisor responded to 101 complaints from citizens on code violations. 5 additional code violations were pro-actively identified.
- 2 full time Code Enforcement Inspectors and the Code Enforcement Supervisor initiated 142 new cases in March in addition to the associated workload and re-inspections on existing cases.
- The top code activity in March was Offensive Premises with 35 cases.
- 5 parking tickets were issued for a parking violations related to junked vehicles on public streets and 2 summons were issued for offensive premises.
- Code Enforcement Inspectors performed a total of 403 inspections related to code and housing violations.
