BACKGROUND AND ISSUE ANALYSIS:

Attached please find the April 2009 monthly report for the Code Enforcement Division.

- 2 full time Code Enforcement Inspectors and the Code Enforcement Supervisor responded to 106 complaints from citizens on code violations. 5 additional code violations were proactively identified.
- 2 full time Code Enforcement Inspectors and the Code Enforcement Supervisor initiated 151 new cases in April in addition to the associated workload and re-inspections on existing cases.
- The top code activity in April was Offensive Premises with 34 cases.
- 4 parking tickets were issued for a parking violations related to junked vehicles on public streets.
- Code Enforcement Inspectors performed a total of 337 inspections related to code and housing violations.
