Inpatient Detox Program

303-441-1281 (24 Hours)

The Inpatient Detox Program provides safe detoxification from alcohol and/or drugs 24 hours a day, seven days a week, in a 30-bed facility. The Inpatient Detox, located at the Addiction Recovery Center, is the only non-medical detox in Boulder County. Detox staff provides:

- Individualized monitoring for safe detox from alcohol and/or drugs
- Assessment for counseling needs
- Information and education on alcohol and drugs
- Case management and referral for medical, housing, legal, and employment services
- Clients receive support and guidance throughout their stay and every client is given a referral for ongoing care.

Outpatient Program

The Outpatient Program promotes healthy lifestyles through a wide array of services for anyone experiencing problems with alcohol and drugs. Our counselors are highly trained, certified professionals who work with each client to create individualized care plans. Outpatient services include:

- Intake and assessment to determine needs and level of services
- Treatment and counseling for individuals, groups, and families
- Court-ordered substance abuse evaluations (for indigent clients only)
- Monitoring through breathalyzers and anti-abuse
- Psychiatric evaluations, evaluations for medications, and medication monitoring for clients in the program
- Information and referral to other treatment resources in the community
- Clients may receive services that range from short-term counseling to long-term, enhanced outpatient treatment. The Outpatient Program also works with the community to create strong, ongoing support systems for clients

Impaired Driver Program

Preventing drinking and driving has emerged as a top community priority. The Impaired Driver Program, in conjunction with law enforcement and other community groups, is making a difference. The program provides Level II Education and Therapy to clients who have been arrested and convicted of impaired driving offenses in Boulder County. The program is designed to promote responsible behavior through better decision making, thereby reducing repeat DUI (driving under the influence) offenses. Reduced-cost services for indigent, low-income clients are available, as well as referral to bilingual (Spanish/English) services.

Intensive Teen Outpatient Program (ITOP)

ITOP works with teenagers, ages 14 to 17, who have abused alcohol and drugs, are involved with the juvenile justice system, and are at risk for out-of-home placement. The goal is to reduce or eliminate alcohol and drug use among these teens through evaluation, assessment, individual and group counseling, and case management services. Parents are encouraged to participate in group therapy, and may also be referred for individual treatment and support.

Specialized Women's Services (SWS)

SWS works with pregnant and parenting mothers to establish sober lifestyles, and create a safe environment for their children. SWS works closely with collateral agencies, such as department of Social Services to reduce the risk of out of home placement and to reduce the amount of time children might spend in placement due to parental drug/alcohol use. SWS offers gender specific groups covering a variety of topics including relapse prevention skills, parenting skills, nutrition, etc.

Sobriety Monitoring Program

The Addiction Recovery Center (ARC) offers a program to monitor clients that are either self-referred or referred by other programs such as Probation or Social Services. The monitoring office is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

We offer daily, twice daily, and random breathalyzers for ARC- registered clients, as well as emergency monitoring for ARC clients without a sheet, and for walk-ins.

We monitor Antabuse when the client provides the prescription, physician's name and phone number, along with a monthly letter certifying that they are in treatment with a counselor.

- Daily and twice-daily breaths are \$15.00 per week or \$60.00 per month
- Random breaths are \$30.00 per month or \$15.00 per 1/2 month only
- Anti-abuse is \$15.00 per week or \$60.00 per monthly
- Emergency Monitoring, \$5.00/test (with valid ID)
- Emergency Monitoring without valid ID, \$10.
