**2012 New Neighborhood Registration Form**

The Neighborhood Group Leaders Association was established to build a communication link between the City and the neighborhood groups. Registered neighborhood groups receive information from the Planning Division of the Community Development Department, the Planning and Zoning Commission agendas, and the City Council agendas. In addition registered neighborhood Group Leaders meet monthly to keep abreast of city, community, and school district issues, and usually invite a guest speaker to address the current issues.

To continue to participate in the Neighborhood Group Leaders Association and to continue receive information from the City, each neighborhood group must renew their registration annually. The purpose of the renewal is to verify that each group is still active, and to confirm the name and address of each group's leader.

Registered neighborhood groups are required to meet at least once a year to elect a Group Leader. Information on a variety of City issues will be mailed to the designated Group Leader for distribution to neighborhood residents. Neighborhoods that are active in the Group Leaders Association are eligible to apply for Neighborhood Activity and Neighborhood Improvement Grants. The neighborhood group must be open to all residents or owners of real property within the neighborhood group boundaries.
