**Fast Tracks and Transportation Updates:**

Brought a map listing street rehabilitation projects

The city is working to obtain some Federal funds for work on the flood plain at South Main and Left Hand Creek.

Work on the downtown alley project will begin this summer. The east side 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Ave this year and west side in 2012.

Boulder County is currently working on transportation master plan.

LOBO trail work (bike trail from Longmont to Boulder) is ongoing.

Flex Services (Fort Collins to Longmont) bus service available.

Regional buses at 8<sup>th</sup> and Coffman and Local buses that currently meet at 6<sup>th</sup> and Kimbark will all be moved to 8<sup>th</sup> and Coffman beginning in August.

Phase 1 of Fast Track funds now available and the terminal will hopefully be built by 2015.
