

Details

- The person who checks out the kit is responsible for returning the bag and its contents. **Be sure that book club members know to return their books to the person who checked out the book bag**, and not to the library. Use the sign out sheet in the notebook to keep track of who has which book.
- Overdue kits will be fined 50 cents per day. Kits that are returned incomplete will be fined 50 cents per day until the missing part is returned.
- The replacement cost of an entire kit is \$142.00. The replacement cost of individual parts of the kit will depend on the cost of each particular item.
- Books in a Bag must be returned to the Circulation Desk inside the Library. Please do not put kits in book drops.

Books in a Bag Basics

- Book discussion kits, developed just for book clubs, contain ten copies of a “discussable” book, discussion questions, and an author profile.
- The kits may be checked out for six weeks.
- No more than one Books in a Bag kit may be checked out to an individual at one time.
