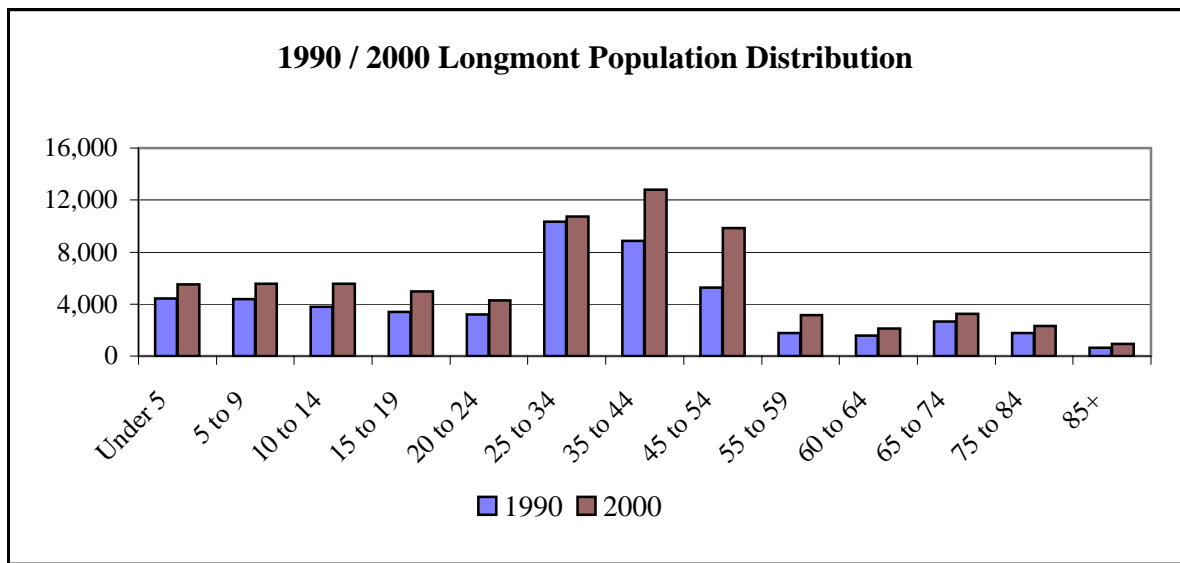

LONGMONT POPULATION DISTRIBUTION BY AGE

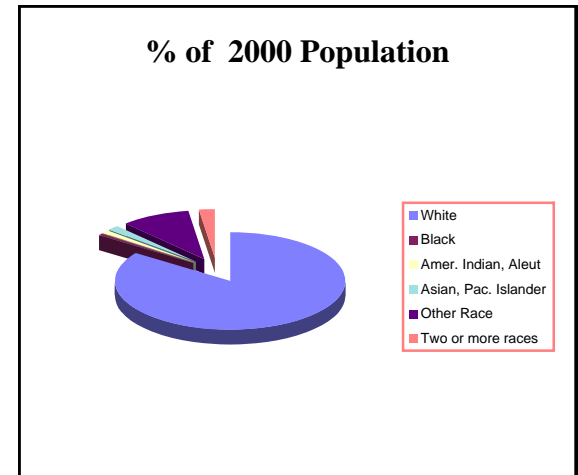
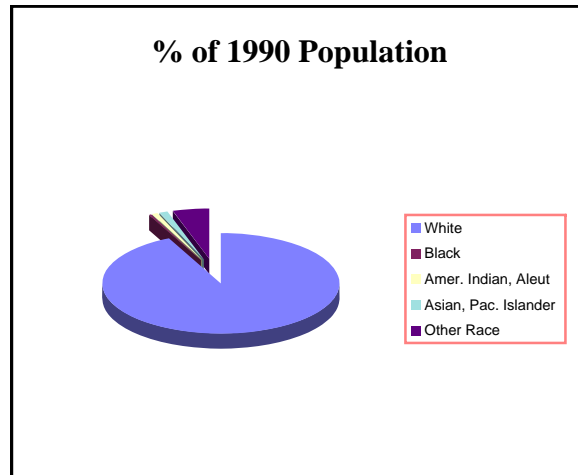
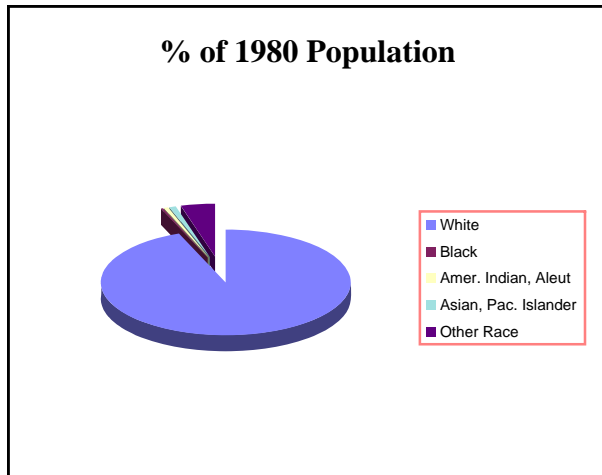
