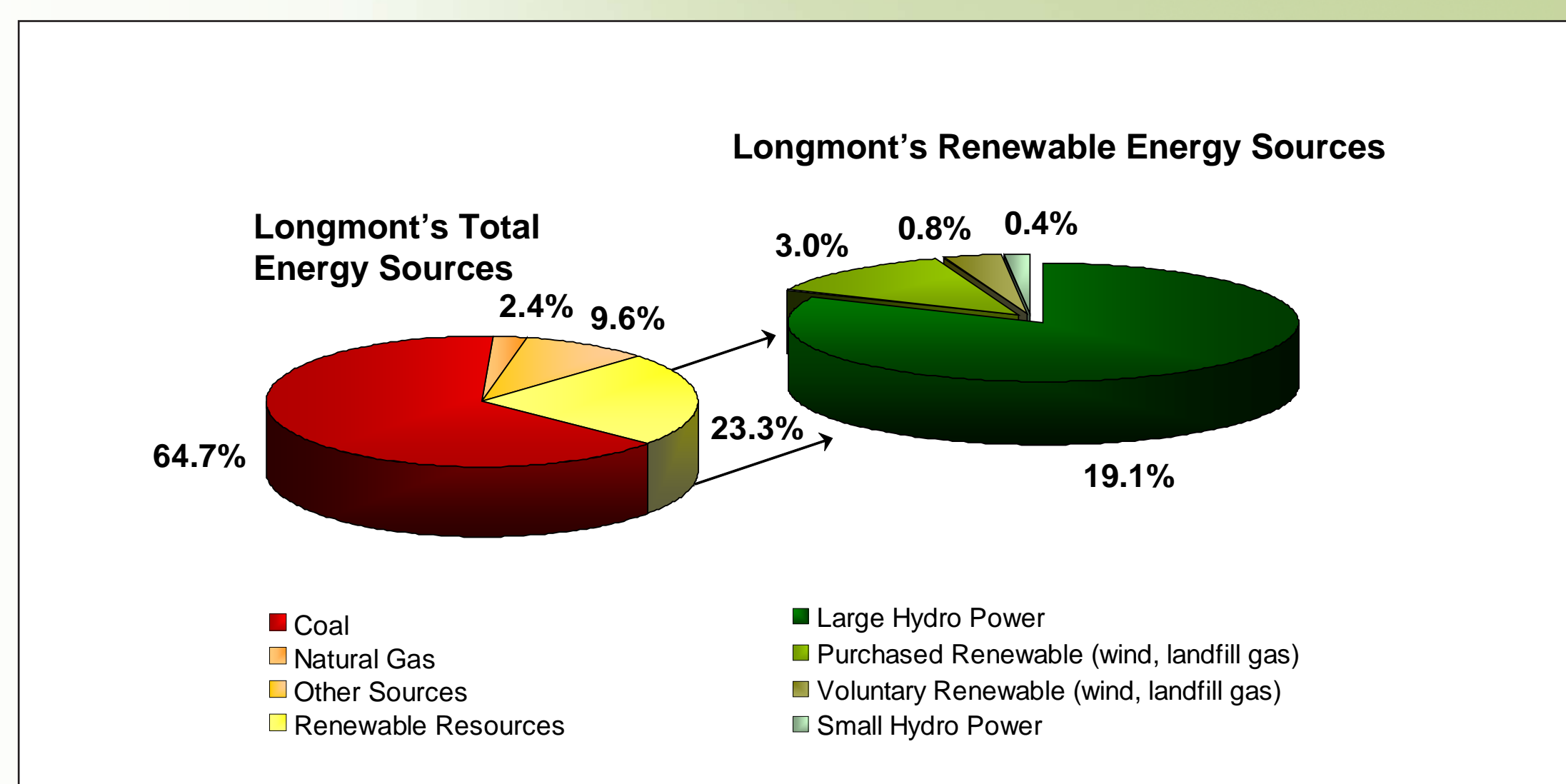


# Renewable Energy



## Longmont has a history of obtaining electricity from renewable and non-fossil fuel sources.

About 23.3% of Longmont's power supply (2008) is from hydro, wind, landfill gas and other renewable sources:



One of the first utilities in Colorado to offer a voluntary customer purchase program for renewable energy. Our renewable energy meets stringent consumer and environmental protection criteria.

The Solar Power Partners Program provides residential rebates in partnership with the Governor's Energy Office for installing solar electric panels.

- Seeking approvals for a new hydro generating project at the city-owned Ralph Price Reservoir
- Purchase additional electricity from a wind facility to be completed by 2010
