

# Energy Efficiency - Residential



## The City offers many services and incentives to help residents reduce electric consumption:

### Free Services:

- Home energy efficiency workshops
- Consumer education and information materials
- Bill and rate analysis
- Home energy audit (walk-through audit by a non-certified auditor)
- Watt meter equipment loan

### Subsidized Services:

- Residential Energy Audit Program (certified auditor)

### Discounts:

- Compact fluorescent light (CFL) discounts at local retailers

### Rebates:

- On home insulation and sealing (Center for ReSource Conservation)
- On Energy Star appliances

### Other Programs

- Neighborhood Energy Efficiency Sweep Program, volunteers go door to door in selected low-income neighborhoods installing free energy and water saving devices (CFLs, low flow showerheads, etc.) and providing efficiency/recycling/environmental materials
- Energy Star New Homes Program supports energy efficient new home construction and education
