



HEAT TRANSFER EQUIPMENT CLEANING WASTE DISCHARGE RENEWAL APPLICATION

This application is a formal request to continue permission already granted by the City of Longmont to discharge wastes generated only from heat transfer equipment cleaning operations to the City of Longmont MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System) under Chapter 14.26 of the Longmont Municipal Code.

Permission to discharge shall be valid for 90 days or until the date of expiration of Certification under the General Minimal Industrial Discharge Permit issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, whichever comes first.
