Longmont Power and Communications wants to remind customers that using LED decorative lights can be a key part of saving money and energy at the holidays. While traditional incandescent holiday light bulbs use 6 watts per bulb, LED holiday lights generally use .08 watts -- a substantial energy reduction. And LED holiday save money as well. A typical strand of 50 lights can cost up to \$4.50 to run for the entire season. While a strand of LED lights cost less than 6 cents.
