

SUPPLY LIST FOR PASTEL WORKSHOP

Table Top Easel or Standing Easel

Pastels

If the participant does not have pastels, they could purchase a box of Faber Castel (72 half sticks) retail price \$32. Or if they order them from ASW on the internet, they could buy this box for \$20.00 to \$25.00 (sale price). This is a good starter set for the introduction to pastels.

Rembrandt is also good for a starter set (but more expensive than Faber Castel).

Wallis paper (museum grade) comes in pads of 8 sheets size 9 x 12" for a cost of \$20 per pad. These sheets of paper can be taped onto a piece of foam board with masking tape. Foam board may be purchased at Hobby Lobby. Hobby Lobby will cut the foam board to the size requested. For a 9 x 12" sheet of Wallis paper, the foam board should be at least 11 x14".

Participant should have a small sponge brush (can be purchased at Home Depot) for under \$1.

Gloves in a Bottle protects the hands from absorbing the pastel, or if the participant would like they could wear thin clear plastic gloves.

A couple of photographs to work from, or set up a still life.

Viva paper towels

Newspaper (to cover table)

Wear clothes that can be washed. Bring an apron if you have one.

Most of all, the participant should have the desire to have fun with this great medium. It is a fun medium and offers creativity.
