◆ General Booth Information ◆

☞ **Vehicles must be off site by 7:00am**

☞ All booths must be ready by 7:00 am, Saturday, July 10th. Exceptions to this time must be pre-approved. There will be security on site both Friday night and Saturday night. However, we are unable to guarantee the safety of any items left overnight.

☞ There is no schedule for who will arrive at what specific time and on-site loading spaces are limited, so please plan accordingly and remember your parking pass for unloading purposes.

☞ There will be a Full-Time Event Staff assigned to specific areas. They will be wearing red staff shirts. Please communicate with them any questions, needs or problems.

Communication by you, to your supplier: We will have a cell phone available for your use. Let an Event Staff Manager know you would like to make a call and they will get a phone for you.



◆ Load-in & Load-out Procedure ◆

Load-in times at Roger's Grove:

Option #1: Friday, July 9th
9:00 am – 2:00 pm

Option #2: Saturday, July 10th
5:00 am – 6:45 am

No vehicles will be allowed to drive on the path during the race which begins at 7am.

Load-out times:

Option #1: Saturday, July 10th
*varies with area

* See your committee representative for your area.

*Exceptions to these times must be pre-approved. Alternate load-out routes will be given.

ONLY Restaurants/Entertainers will be allowed to enter at the Hover Street parking lot entrance.

The Boston Street entrance is for all other vendors. Follow the path with your “flashers” on, go slow and refer to your map for your specific unloading location. The confirmation packet will have specific area instructions. No vehicles may remain on site for the day. All vehicles will need to park at the Boulder County Fairgrounds. The RTD shuttle is available beginning at 7:00am on Saturday, July 10.

Parking Permit: All restaurant vehicles – loading in/out items and delivering additional supplies during the day will need to have a permit easily visible (hanging from the rear view mirror) to the parking attendants. If the police officer is unable to see the permit, they will direct the vehicle to regular parking (Boulder County Fairgrounds). We are providing one (1) temporary parking permit per vendor.

◆ Parking ◆
