



Volunteer Information Sheet

The Process

1. Read all the information to determine if this program is appropriate for you.
2. Complete and sign the Volunteer Application.
3. Submit the application to the Longmont Senior Services: 910 Longs Peak Ave, Longmont, CO 80501, Fax # (303) 651-8413
4. When we have a match, based on your requests, we will call you.
5. You confirm or decline that you can “chase” the snow away.
6. If you say “yes,” we will call the client to let them know you have accepted. We will also tell them your name and approximately when they can expect you.
7. If you are paired up with someone for the winter, it will be your responsibility to watch the weather and have the snow cleared from the public sidewalk within 24 hours of a snowfall.
8. Pat your self on the back for being a great citizen by helping others!

General Information

- * This program is for seniors or disabled people who physically and financially unable to clear their sidewalk of snow.
- * The city ordinance basically states: Within 24-hours after any snow or ice stops falling on a public sidewalk, it is the duty of every owner, property manager, and every adult occupant of a single-family dwelling, abutting a public sidewalk to remove or cause the removal of snow and ice.
- * Volunteers are responsible for their own equipment (i.e. shovel).
- * Volunteers are responsible for dressing appropriate to the weather and conditions.
- * Volunteers are responsible for evaluating the site and working in a safe manner. We don't want anyone to get hurt, so call Kari at (303) 651-8495 if you have concerns.
- * If you are unable to take care of your client for some reason (i.e. sick, vacation) or wish to stop volunteering, please call Kari at (303) 651-8495.
- * Some clients may be in need of additional assistance (beyond shoveling), if they ask for your help, please let them know you have been authorized only to help with shoveling but they can call the Senior Center at (303) 651-8411 or you can offer to call for them.
- * If you arrive at a client's home and the snow has already been cleared, please call us so we can clarify if there really is a need at that address in the future.
